

Bengaluru: Five major challenges are staring chief minister Basavaraj Bommai in the face as he gears up to expand his cabinet in a day or two amid increasing expectations from his MLA colleagues as well as people.

His biggest challenge at the moment is to stem the aspiration levels among the legislators, as several of them are eyeing ministerial positions and lobbying hard to get there. As he himself acknowledged on Monday, his immediate task is to strike a fine balance in the cabinet with a fair representation of regions and communities. Those left out in the first round of expansion might, however, nurse a grievance and step up pressure on the CM to induct them in the second round.

# REBUILDING PARTY

last week. The CM has all the figures on his fingertips as he represented Karnataka in the GST Council. Since the BJP rules both the state and the Centre, the CM cannot raise his pitch while asking for early release of funds. He has to get them by employing his suave skills with the Union ministers. Since the first wave of Covid-19 broke

out in March last year, Karnataka's industries, businesses and jobs have badly bruised. The government has spent thou-

sands of crores on beefing up health infrastructure. testing and treating infected persons in both government and prihospitals, vate mostly on borro-

wed funds. Not only have tax revenues taken a hit due to lockdowns and other restrictions, there is no end to the sight of the agony anytime soon as experts are warning of a third wave striking. Checkposts have come up, slowing down movement of people and commodities on interstate borders.

On the vaccination front, the health authorities have been beset with demands from people for both first and second dose of vaccine shots. While the state has not even achieved 50% of vaccination coverage, those who have received both shots number just about 6.5 million. Vaccine availability is far short of the demand, leaving large chunks of the population exposed to the virus.

Amid a raging scramble for vaccine doses, parts of Karnataka have been ravaged by monsoon floods, with thousands of homes destroyed and roads and bridges washed away. Affected persons are pinning hopes on the Bommai regime as his native Mumbai-Karnataka region is among the worst-affected areas.

The R value, or effective reproduction rate of a virus, shows how many people an individual can infect and is considered a reliable metric on the spread and prevalence of a virus like Covid-19. The value must be below 1 for active cases to come down.

"It appears that overall R for India is now again greater than 1. # **Power-sharing Pact Chances Recede Amid Taliban's Gains**

Spectre of a deadly civil war is looming large in Afghanistan, as hope for a peaceful negotiated power-sharing agreement between the government of President Ashraf Ghani and the Taliban is receding fast. Taliban is refusing to agree to a ceasefire and is insisting that Ghani should step down. It further wants that the talks should be held to set up an Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan, a proposition not acceptable to Ghani and may be also to the US.

If the deadlock persists, unpredictable radical forces could emerge in Afghanistan and its neighbourhood that would have far reaching implications for the world. In this interconnected globalised world, no country will remain safe even if it being thousands of miles away. The root cause of what we are now witnessing in Afghanistan is the result of decades of foreign interventions by the USSR and the US,

and interference by Pakistan. Even now, the way the world is warming up to the obscurantist Taliban would in no way create an atmosphere where the latter is compelled to seek a solution on negotiating table. So, why then the world is now expecting the Taliban to be reasonable and talk to

Ashraf Ghani? Why would they

talk? They are now controlling more than half territory of the country and four out of seven international trading routes connecting Afghanistan with Turkmenistan, Tajikistan, Iran, and Pathereby generating massive revenues to further fuel their war.

Once the Taliban captured Wakhan corridor that connects Afghanistan with China through a 76 km long border, it became imperative for China to placate the group to protect its soft underbelly of Uighur separatism in Xinjiang. At milarly, it wants to escape the a meeting with Taliban leader Mullah Abdul Ghani Baradar in Tianjin on July 27, Chinese foreign minister Wang Yi described the group as "a pivotal military and political force in Afghanistan that is expected to play an important role in reconstructing the country". Reciprocating the gesture, the Taliban assured China that it will not allow its territory to be used by any terror group against a

third country. Earlier, the Taliban leaders gave a similar assurance to Russia, as the latter fears that the Taliban takeover could fuel insurgencies in Central Asian countries like Tajikistan and Uzbekistan. Similarly, Iran separately held meeting with the Taliban leaders to maintain its influence and ensure safety and security of Shia Hazara popula-



Mullah Abdul Ghani Baradar in Tianjin on July 27, Chinese foreign minister Wang Yi described the group as "a pivotal military and political force in Afghanistan that is expected to play an important role in

reconstructing the country". Reciprocating the gesture, the Taliban assured China that it will not allow its territory to be used by any terror group against a third country.

Earlier, the Taliban leaders gave a similar assurance to Russia, as the latter fears that the Taliban takeover could fuel insurgencies in Central Asian countries like Tajikistan and Uzbekistan. Similarly, Iran separately held meeting with the Taliban leaders to maintain its influence and ensure safety and security of Shia Hazara popu-

"There are some provinces in which one district has monopolised all the government seats. The Republic cannot be made with inherited family," Ghani said.

Meanwhile, hajj and religious affairs minister Mohammad Qasim Halimi said those who are spreading pro-Taliban propaganda and are working in the system should be controlled. "There are some individuals in society, even government employees, who presume to speak for us, and are making cruel statements," Halimi said.

Backing India's position, former Canadian minister Chris Alexander recently claimed that Pakistan is backing the Taliban and is complicit in proxy wars. He tweeted, "Taliban fighters waiting to cross the border from Pakistan to Afghanistan... Anyone still denying that Pakistan is engaged in an 'act of aggression' against Afghanistan is complicit in proxy war & war crimes."

### Pakistanis Married to Former Militants from Valley Detained During March to LOC

Srinagar: The Jammu and Kashmir police on Monday detained several Pakistani women married to former militants from the Valley, as they tried to march towards the Line of Control (LoC) in Uri area of Baramulla district in northern Kashmir in a desperate attempt to return to their homeland.

The group of women living in Kashmir reiterated their demand that they be deported, stating that their repeated attempts to get the Indian citizenship had failed.

The police said it had detained about 15 women and three children till late evening. "We have detained around 15 women and they will be released soon," senior superintendent

of police (Baramulla), Mohammad Rayees Bhat, told ET. During their protest march, the women carried banners pleading that they were from Pakistan and they should be allowed to meet their families "We appeal to both India and Pakistan to

our country," read the banners. More than 350 women from across the LoC and Pakistan – who had married Kashmiri men when the latter had crossed the border for arms training in the 1990s and early 2000s - came to the Valley after 2010.

This happened as the Omar Abdullah-led J&K government in 2010 introduced a policy for return and rehabilitation of those who crossed the LoC between 1989 and 2009 but never took part in active militancy. They were asked to come back via Nepal, which was an unofficial route to return to avail the benefits of the policy.
